HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

1. In the present writ petition, the prayer of the petitioner is that the employees junior to the petitioner have been granted the pay scale, which is more than the pay scale of petitioner, which is contrary to the settled principle of law. Further prayer of the petitioner is for issuance of a direction to the respondents to step up the pay of the petitioner equivalent to his juniors with all consequential benefits.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the grievance raised in the present petition has already been raised by the petitioner in the representation dated 29.04.2023 (Annexure P-9) which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

5. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case the representation dated 29.04.2023 (Annexure P-9) has been received in the office of concerned authorities and is still pending, the same will be decided by the authorities concerned within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of copy of this order.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
