1. Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C is for setting aside the order dated 26.08.2016 wherein an application filed by the prosecution under Section 319 Cr.P.C was dismissed, and for setting aside the order dated 11.05.2017 only to the extent whereby the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Sangrur dismissed the 319 revision qua respondents No. 2 and 3.
