By way of present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.25 dated 15.04.2023 registered under Sections 323, 325, 148 and 149 IPC and Section 307 IPC added later on, at Police Station GRP Bathinda, District Bathinda.

As per the allegations, on 07.04.2023, petitioner along with others, armed with different kinds of weapons, attacked complainant- Rahul Kumar and caused numerous injuries to him. One of the injury was found to be dangerous to life attracting Section 307 IPC.

Learned counsel contends that the injury attributed to the petitioner is simple in nature; that co-accused namely Leela alias Rakesh Kumar has already been allowed regular bail by this Court order dated 02.04.2024 passed by this Court in CRM-M-55607 of 2023.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court does not find the present case to be fit for grant of anticipatory bail, having regard to the nature of injuries which have been sustained by the complainant and the fact that

the petitioner was a member of the unlawful assembly, which caused injuries to the complainant.

Dismissed.
