1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondent for disobeying the order dated 07.07.2022 passed in CWP-14244-2022.

2. Reply by way of affidavit on behalf of the respondent filed in the Registry is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan the same and place it at appropriate place.

3. Learned counsel for the respondent has submitted that the order dated 07.07.2022 passed in CWP-14244-2022 has been complied with and speaking order dated 13.09.2023 has been passed.

4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.

5. However, if any grievance of the petitioners is left unredressed, they would be at liberty to raise the same in any alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
