1. Present criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus seeking protection of the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members sacrosanct under Article 21 of the Constitution of India from the private respondents and the Police Constabulary acting at the behest of the private respondents. Further a prayer has been made for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 4 to prevent the false implication of the petitioner in frivolous cases as threatened by the respondents No.5 to 7 in league with the police officials and to initiate fastidious action on the representation moved by the petitioner.

2. Learned State counsel has pointed out that in the present case, the complaint dated 02.04.2024 (Annexure P-2) filed against the petitioner has been looked into and has been filed by the police stating to

be a civil dispute.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of the stand taken by the learned State counsel, the present criminal writ petition has been rendered infructuous and the same may be disposed of as such.

4. In view of the above, the present criminal writ petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
