JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to promote him to the rank of Officiating Sub-Inspector.
2. The petitioner on account of lack of information could not undergo 'Upper School Course' which is required for promotion to the rank of Sub-Inspector. The petitioner concededly has turned 55 years of age and is going to retire on 31.12.2024.
3. On being confronted with aforesaid facts, learned State counsel conceded that petitioner being more than 55 years old is exempted from Upper School Course, thus, his case would be considered for promotion to the rank of Officiating Sub-Inspector. He assures the



Court that the competent authority would pass an appropriate order within 8 weeks from today.

4. In the wake of statement of learned State counsel the present petition stands disposed of.
