KULDEEP TIWARI. J.(Oral)

1. On 27.05.2024, this Court had passed the hereinafter extracted order,
upon the instant petition:-

“It is not in dispute that the injury, which was given by the present petitioner with iron rod on the ring finger of the victim Didar Singh, is stated to be simple in nature.

Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the grant of pre-arrest bail to the present petitioner. He has also shown the photographs of the victim- Didar Singh and submitted that he has suffered 18 stitches on account of injuries suffered by him.

On a pin point query put to him, that whom the head injury is attributed, he categorically answered that the head injury is attributed to co-accused Gurdeep Singh.

In view of the above, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation, as the co-accused has already been granted the relief of anticipatory bail, to whom simple injuries are attributed. In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall, however,



join the investigation as and when called for and shall also abide by the conditions specified under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.

Adjourned to 18.7.2024. ”

2. Today, the learned State counsel on instructions imparted to him by ASI Jeevan Lal, submits that the petitioner has already joined the investigation and he is fully co-operating with the investigation process and he is not required for any further custodial interrogation.

3. In view of the specific stand taken by the learned State counsel, the present petition is **allowed** and order dated 27.05.2024 is, hereby, made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
