Present civil writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of direction in the nature of mandamus, directing the official respondents to get demarcated the Govt. passage No.329 which is going towards the land of the petitioners as the private respondents are illegally occupied the passage and there is no other way towards the land of the petitioners. Further prayer has been made to direct the official respondents to decide the legal notice dated 20.12.2023 (Annexure P-6) served by the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that for the redressal of their grievance, petitioners have served legal notice dated 20.12.2023 (Annexure P-6) upon the official respondents but the same has not been taken into consideration till date. He has further submitted that petitioners would be satisfied if their legal notice dated 20.12.2023 (Annexure P-6) is decided in a time bound manner.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Navneet Singh, Sr. D.A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents-State.

Heard.

After hearing counsel for the parties, respondent No.3-Tehsildar Ferozepur, District Ferozepur is directed to decide the legal notice dated 20.12.2023 (Annexure P-6) served by the petitioners expeditiously preferably within one month from today, in accordance with law.

In view of the above, present petition is disposed of.
