1. The petitioners have filed the Criminal Writ Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India with a prayer to issue appropriate directions to respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.3 and 4. A further prayer has been made with a prayer to direct the respondent No.3 not to harass the petitioners and their family members illegally on the basis of false and frivolous complaints moved by respondent No.4.
2. A short reply by way of an affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Circle Rural Patiala, District Patiala was filed on behalf of the respondent No.1-State.
3. Learned State counsel submits that a complaint dated 08.04.2023 was submitted by respondent No.4 and the petitioners were called in the said complaint for inquiry. He further submits that the said inquiry has already been ordered to be closed on 06.01.2024.

He next contends that since the inquiry has been ordered to be closed, the petitioners shall not be called by the police in connection with the complaint moved by the respondent No.4.

4. In view of the statement made by the learned State counsel, nothing survives in the present petition and the present petition is accordingly disposed off.
