Prayer in this petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner by providing him personal security as the life and liberty of the petitioner is in danger as he has been attacked multiple times with intention to kill by different persons who projected themselves as a part of Kissan organisations.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner belongs to the political party i.e. Bhartiya Janta Party and he is Halqa Incharge of area Raja Sansi District Amritsar. The petitioner has also contested the MLA Elections from the constituency Raja Sansi (Amritsar), which were held in the year 2022. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner has also filed representation (Annexure P-4) dated 18.04.2024 to the Senior Superintendent of



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Police, Amritsar Rural raising his apprehension as mentioned in the present petition but the same has not yet been considered and no action has been taken thereon. He further submits that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No. 4– Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural) Amritsar to decide the aforementioned representation filed by the petitioner and take necessary action thereon.

3. As per the status report filed by learned State counsel, it has been stated that during enquiry, it has been found that proper security arrangements are made by the administration during the rally organized by the petitioner. It has also been stated that no untoward incident has ever happened with the petitioner and proper security arrangements are made by the police during his road show and at present there is no threat from anyone but as a preventive measure, the PCR patrolling party has been directed for keeping a watch at the house of the petitioner and he has been given the mobile numbers of Station House Officer, Police Station Rajasansi and the matter has been brought to the notice of senior officers.

4. In view of the above, no further directions are required to be passed in the present petition and the same is disposed of accordingly.
