The petitioner, by way of present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in case bearing FIR No. 30 dated 04.03.2024, under Sections 353, 186, 332, 307 & 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station Bhawanigarh, District Sangrur.

[2] Learned State Counsel, on instructions from the quarter concerned, submits that petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of order dated 06.05.2024 and is not required for custodial interrogation.
