1. Prayer made in the present petition is for setting aside order dated 29.08.2019 and reply to legal notice dated 01.06.2020.
2. Learned counsel submits that on account of the services rendered by the father of the petitioner as Sweeper with the respondent Department and died on 30.09.2013, the plea taken for not releasing the pensionary benefits in the reply to the legal notice by way of memo No. 146 dated 01.06.2020, Annexure P-13, was the non-submission of succession certificate which though learned counsel submits was furnished on 14.08.2017, however he, on instructions, submits alongwith the decree of the civil Court and the other requisite documents shall now be re-submitted within a period



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of four weeks and would be satisfied if a time bound direction direction is given to the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner.

3. Learned State counsel has no objection to the limited prayer made.

4. In view of the aforesaid and without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the claim of the petitioner expeditiously preferably within 4 months, which this Court has no reason to believe the authorities would not address in a just, fair and reasonable manner. Upon doing so, after notice and hearing offered to them, and if found entitled, grant the benefit forthwith. Needless to say, if the orders are adverse to their interest, the same shall contain reasons and the petitioners shall be free to seek legal redress.
