After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner intends to approach the respondents by filing an appropriate representation for the redressal of her grievance and the respondents be directed to decide the representation of the petitioner in a time bound manner so that the petitioner does not suffer any prejudice.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case any representation/claim is received at the hands of the petitioner, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of any such representation/claim by passing an appropriate speaking order and in case, after the decision any relief is to be extended to the petitioner, the same will be extended, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order to be passed for not accepting the claim of the petitioner for her information and necessary action.
