1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the respondents have called for the record of the eligible employees for promotion to the post of Sub Divisional Engineer in the Category of Diploma Holder as well as degree holders. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the record of the candidates, who are below in seniority than the petitioner in the Category of Degree Holder, have been called but the record of the petitioner has not been called even though, there is no impediment in the promotion of the petitioner as there are no proceedings, which are pending against the petitioner so as to withhold the promotion.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance in the representation dated



20.04.2024 (Annexure P-18) but the same is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a direction is issued to the respondents to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case, the representation dated 20.04.2024 (Annexure P-18) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of six weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order. Learned counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioner, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be given for not accepting the claim of the petitioner in the speaking order to be passed.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
