1. This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.833 dated 10.10.2013 under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Karnal Civil Lines, District Karnal.

2. On 01.01.2015, the following order was passed:-

“The present petition has been filed by petitioner Jaipal for grant of anticipatory bail. As per the prosecution allegations he has got allotted the second plot from HUDA by concealment of facts.



Learned counsel for the petitioner has drawn my attention to the order dated 10.07.2014 passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court in CRM-M-20554 of 2014, wherein it is mentioned that the issue of double allotment is under consideration before this Court and Advocate General, Haryana has given an undertaking that in such like cases no coercive method will be adopted.

In view of the said undertaking given by the Advocate General, Haryana, no separate order was passed. The present petitioner is also entitled the same protection at the present stage.

Post the matter on 13.01.2015.

To be heard along with CRM-M-26292 of 2013.”

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Rajbir, at the very outset, informs the Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

4. In view of the statement of learned State counsel, order dated 01.01.2015 is hereby made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the terms and conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

5. The petition stands disposed of.
