1. In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioners is that the petitioners have not been promoted to the post of Clerk from the date juniors of the petitioners were promoted despite the fact that there was no impediment in the promotion of the petitioners, from the said date hence, the respondents be directed to consider the claim of the petitioners for promotion to the post of Clerk w.e.f the date employees junior to the petitioners were promoted with all consequential benefits.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the grievance raised in the present petition has already been raised by the petitioners in the legal notice dated 17.11.2023 (Annexure P-3) which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioners will be satisfied at this stage in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

4. Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case the legal notice dated 17.11.2023 (Annexure P-3) has been received in the office of concerned authorities and is still pending consideration, the same will be decided by the authorities concerned within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of copy of this order and in case, after the decision of the representation, any benefit accrues to the petitioners, the same will also be released to them otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order for not accepting the claim of the petitioners for their information and necessary action.
6. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
