This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 read with Section 2-A of the Contempt of Courts Act read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondent for disobeying the order dated 21.01.2019 passed in CWP-19111-2018.

Perusal of the compliance report and the order sheets shows that the petitioners have been taken back in service and an amount of Rs.7,43,605/- has already been paid to petitioner No.1 and an amount of Rs.7,37,153/- has already been paid to petitioner No.2 by way of demand draft.

In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to continue with the present petition any more.

Dismissed.

However, if any grievance of the petitioners is left unredressed, they would be at liberty to raise the same in any alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
