KARAMJIT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

1. Counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner No.1 a boy aged about 20 years is into livein relationship with petitioner No.2 a girl aged about 20 years and the said relationship is opposed by respondents No.4 to 10 who have threatened to cause physical harm to the petitioners and in this regard petitioners have given their representation dated 01.05.2024 to respondent No.2 but the police authorities failed to take any action in this regard.

2. Counsel for the petitioners submits that aforesaid private respondents No.4 to 10 have threatened to cause harm to both the petitioners and in this regard, representation 01.05.2024 (Annexure P-3) was given to Senior Superintendent of Police, Ambala but till date no action has been taken by the concerned authority in this regard.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Neeraj Sheoran, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of

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State of Haryana. He submits that the concerned authority will look into the matter and take decision on the representation of the petitioners in accordance with law.

5. In view of above, without going into the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Ambala to consider representation 01.05.2024 (Annexure P-3) and to take action if so warranted in accordance with law.

6. However, any observations made in this order will not be construed as an expression of opinion on the validity of the relationship of the petitioners. It is also made clear that respondents No.4 to 10 are at liberty to avail appropriate remedy available to them under law against the petitioners. In case the petitioners have committed any offence, law will take its own course.
