The present petition has been filed by the petitioner for grant of regular bail in case arising out of FIR No.5 dated 04.01.2024 registered under Sections 21(b), 25 and 27-A of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act read with Section 25 and 27 of Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station City Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur.
