By way of present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C, the
petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR (Annexure P-1) as under: -

FIR No.	Dated	Sections	Police Station
1011	15.12.2023	406, 420 IPC	Yamuna Nagar City, District Yamuna Nagar.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance to the order dated 01.10.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
3. During the course of hearing on 01.10.2024, following order had been passed: -

“1. Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Suresh Kumar, submits that admittedly, no amount was



transferred in the account of the petitioner. However, amounts were transferred by the complainant in the account of Salman, from where it was further transferred to the account of the petitioner. However, on a query, he could not specify any such major amount having been transferred in the account of the petitioner. Admittedly, the petitioner is not having any criminal antecedents.

2. *List on 05.11.2024.*

3. *In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join investigation within seven days from today and co-operate with the same. In the event of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/ Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS.”*

4. Learned State counsel on instructions received from S.I. Suresh informs the Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is neither required for further investigation nor for any custodial interrogation.

5. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 01.10.2024 passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 01.10.2024 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS. Further the

petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioner; he will not tamper with the evidence nor will influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

6. The petition stands allowed.
7. It is made clear that anything contained hereinabove shall not be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
