1. This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0524, dated 04.09.2022, under Sections 272, 273, 420, 467, 468, 471 of IPC (Section 63 of Copyright Act, 1957 and Sections 102, 103 and 104 of Trade Marks Act, 1999 added lateron), registered at Police Station Palla, District Faridabad.

2. Vide order dated 07.05.2024, this Court had granted interim bail to the petitioner and directed him to join investigation.

3. Reply by way of an affidavit dated 19.07.2024 of Rajesh Lohan, HPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Sarai, District Faridabad, on behalf of State of Haryana, has already been filed in the Registry and the same is annexed with the file, which is taken on record. Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Jagdish, submits that in compliance of

order dated 07.05.2024, petitioner has joined investigation and he is not required for any custodial interrogation.

4. I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

5. In view of the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required, the order dated 07.05.2024 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. in letter and spirit.

6. Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
