Short reply by way of affidavit dated 28.10.2024 of Mr. Surinder Mohan Paul, Executive Engineer, Field Mechanical and Workshop Division, RSA Shahpurkandi Township has been filed in Court today, which is taken on record.

2. Learned counsel for the respondent on instructions from Mr. Surender Mohan Pal informs that the dues payable to the petitioner shall be released to him within a period of one month from today.
3. In view of the aforesaid undertaking by learned counsel for the respondent, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition.
4. Dismissed as not pressed.
5. Rule stands discharged.

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6. However, in case the needful is not done within the
aforementioned period, as per the undertaking, the petitioner would be at
liberty to seek revival of the contempt petition and in that eventuality,
the erring/concerned Officer would be liable to pay Rs.50,000/- as costs
from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation
expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival
application.
