The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.0021 dated 25.02.2024, registered under Section 381 IPC (Sections 408, 420 and 120-B of IPC added later on), at Police Station Sarabha Nagar, District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 28.05.2024 passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Subhash Raj, has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation on 12.06.2024 and is no longer required for further investigation.

4. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 28.05.2024, passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
