The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus seeking direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondents No.4 to 7 and not to interfere in the matrimonial life of the petitioners at the behest of respondents No.4 to 7 and other relatives.
