The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.173 dated 17.07.2023, registered under Sections 147, 149, 307, 323, 452 & 506 of IPC and Section 25(1)(b) of Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station DLF Phase-I, Gurugram, District Gurugram.
