The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to refund the amount of Rs.1,81,468/- along with interest, which has been deducted from the pensionary benefits of the petitioner, being the amount of Provident Fund and interest on delayed deposit of contribution by Respondent No.4 in the Pension Fund of the petitioner.

Reply by way of affidavit dated 24.05.2024 of Mr. Tarun Kumar, Executive Officer, Municipal Council, Rampura, District Bathinda, on behalf of the respondent no.4 has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record.

In terms of order dated 02.05.2024 passed by this Court, Mr. Tarun Kumar, Executive Officer, Municipal Council, Rampura, District Bathinda and Mr. Vishaldeep, Executive Officer, Municipal Council, District Barnala - Respondent Nos.4 and 5, respectively, are present in the Court and they submits that due amount in question has been refunded to the petitioner, therefore, the present petition has become infructuous.
