MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)

1. The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of directions to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents.
2. In compliance of order dated 08.05.2024, learned State counsel has filed reply by way of an affidavit of Azad Daviner Singh PPS, DSP Sub Division City Batala, Police District Batala today in the Court, which is taken on record subject to all just exceptions.
3. Learned State counsel, at the outset, has drawn the attention of this Court to para No. 4(b) of the affidavit and submitted that in fact husband of the petitioner is facing trial in a criminal case; the police was making efforts to arrest the husband of the petitioner, i.e. Sandeep Singh



@ Sahib Singh, and it is on account of the same that the police had entered the house of the petitioner to arrest her husband. On instructions from ASI Kartar Singh, he has submitted that exaggerated and fabricated submissions had been made by the petitioner that the police had barged into her house on 25.04.2023 for no rhyme or reason, and ransacked their belongings, and thereafter gone away. It has further been submitted that representation dated 06.05.2024 was being enquired into by DSP, Head Quarter, Batala; both the parties had been summoned by the Enquiry Officer however, for reasons best known to the petitioner she had failed to appear and join the proceedings.

- 4. Case has been called twice, however, even on the second call there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.
- 5. In the circumstances, the petition stands dismissed.
