The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking directions to respondents No.2 to 4 to take appropriate legal action against respondent No.5 who had kidnapped/abducted the son of the petitioner namely Rajbir Singh alias Bablu and forcibly took away the important documents and stealing the Tata Tiago Car belonging to the family of the petitioner and taking the signatures of son and daughter of the petitioner on stamp papers and blank papers and despite passing of more than one and half month neither any action has been taken by the police against respondent No.5.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to take an alternate remedy which is equally efficacious i.e. under Section 156(3) Cr.P.C. for addressing his grievance raised in the instant petition.

Prayer is accepted.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
