The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C with a prayer to grant the concession of regular bail to him in case arising out of FIR No.123, dated 20.06.2017, under Sections 307,506,148,149 of IPC and Under Sections 25/27 of Arms Act, Police Station Canal Colony, District Bathinda (Annexure P-1).
