1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in a totally illegal and arbitrary manner, vide impugned order dated 06.11.2023 (Annexure P-8), the claim of the petitioner for regularization of his services as raised under the policy dated 01.10.2003 has been declined.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that no reason has been given by the respondents as to why the petitioner is not entitled for the said benefit and which provisions of the policy is not fulfilled by the petitioner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that keeping in view the instructions received, the impugned order dated 06.11.2023 (Annexure P-8) be treated as withdrawn with liberty to pass a fresh order within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of copy of this order by keeping in view the parameters given by this Court while passing order in ***CWP No.2158 of 2020 titled as Ashish Sharma and others vs. State of Haryana and others, decided on 13.03.2024.***

6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as the impugned order dated 06.11.2023 (Annexure P-8) has been withdrawn, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous and the same may kindly be disposed of as such.
