AMARJOT BHATTI J.

1. Petitioner-Sukhpreet Singh has filed instant petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.0036 dated 06.04.2024 under Sections 323, 341, 506 of IPC, registered at Police Station Kalanaur, District Gurdaspur (Annexure P-1) on the basis of affidavit dated 29.04.2024 (Annexure P-2).

2. Facts of the case are Major Singh gave his statement that on 30.03.2024 at about 11:00 AM, he was going towards his agricultural land. Sukhpreet Singh was already present in the fields. He threatened to teach him a lesson for quarrel which had taken place at religious parade. He gave *datari* blow which hit on his right eyebrow, second blow hit towards back side of his head and third blow hit on right hand little finger. He

raised alarm, as a result Sukhpreet Singh fled away from the spot. He was

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taken to Civil Hospital, Gurdaspur for treatment. With these allegations present FIR has been registered.

3. Petitioner filed this petition for quashing of aforesaid FIR on the basis of compromise. Petitioner and respondent No.2 were directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate for recording their statements on the basis of compromise. Detailed report regarding compromise has been received from the court of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Gurdaspur dated 24.05.2024. Statement of respondent No.2 has been recorded, where he confirmed the compromise with petitioner. He confirmed that this compromise has been effected without any pressure, coercion and undue influence from any side and he has no objection regarding quashing of FIR.

4. Petitioner Sukhpreet Singh also confirmed this fact in his separate statement. Statement of ASI Gurnam Singh is also recorded who further confirmed that accused has not been declared as proclaimed offender.

5. Therefore, from the report of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Gurdaspur, it is clear that compromise has been effected between parties without any pressure, coercion or undue influence, which is acceptable to both the parties.

6. Considering all these factors in mind, in the case in hand both parties have mutually settled their dispute. They are residents of same village. It would enable them to live in peace and harmony and end all litigation started between them. Thus no purpose would be served with the continuation of criminal proceedings.

7. Therefore considering these facts, petition filed by petitioner is accepted and FIR No.0036 dated 06.04.2024 under Sections 323, 341, 506 of IPC, registered at Police Station Kalanaur, District Gurdaspur (Annexure P-1) is quashed.
8. Accordingly, present petition stands accepted.
9. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly.
