1. In the present petition, the grievance being raised by the petitioners is that the selection process, which is being undertaken by the respondents in pursuance to Advertisement No. 3/2023 dated 07.03.2023 is not in a transparent and proper manner and has caused prejudice to the petitioners as the ESP quota reserved posts have been ousted from the advertisement in question.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that all the grievance raised in the present petition have already been raised in the representation 13.03.2024 (Annexure P-9) but the same is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioners will be satisfied, at



this stage, in case a direction is issued to the respondents to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case, the representation 13.03.2024 (Annexure P-9) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of four weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order. Learned counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioners, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioners in the speaking order to be passed.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

6. Ordered accordingly.
