Present applications have been filed for disposing of the main writ petitions in light of the order passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court in *CWP No.6709 of 2015 titled as Joga Singh vs. State of Punjab and others, decided on 03.08.2023.*

Notice of the applications to the counsel opposite.

Ms. Shruti, learned Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. She raises no objection for the grant of prayer as raised in the present applications.

Keeping in view the averments made in the applications, which are duly supported by an affidavit, the applications are allowed subject to all just exceptions and on joint request of learned counsel for the parties, the main writ petitions are taken up for hearing today itself.

CWP-6101-2004, CWP-6110-2004 and CWP-20179-2010

1. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that during the pendency of the present writ petitions, the relief being claimed in the present writ petitions has already been extended in favour of petitioner No.22-Joga Singh (in CWP No.6101-2004) but not in favour of other petitioners whereas, all the petitioners are similarly situated hence, once the benefit has already been extended in favour of petitioner No.22-Joga Singh (in CWP No.6101-2004), the respondents are liable to grant the benefit to all the petitioners.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the claim of the remaining petitioners will also be considered in light of the judgment



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passed in CWP No.6709 of 2015 in favour of petitioner No.22-Joga Singh (in CWP No.6101-2004) and appropriate speaking order on the claim of the petitioners will be passed within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order and in case, it is found that other petitioners are also entitled for the same relief, the same will be extended to them otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order to be passed for not accepting the claim of the petitioners, which reasons will be conveyed to the petitioners for their information and necessary action.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petitions may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

4. Ordered accordingly.

5. Civil miscellaneous application pending if any, also stands disposed of.
