1. Through the instant petition, prayer is made for issuance of *mandamus* upon the official respondents to inquire into the complaint (Annexure P-5) as well as for constitution of a Special Investigation Team (SIT), for the purpose of apprehending respondent no.4, who has been declared as a proclaimed person vide order dated 16.01.2023, passed by the learned Addl.Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Bhiwani, in case FIR No.42 dated 16.02.2023 (Annexure P-4), under Section 174-A of the IPC, registered at Police Station Bhiwani Civil Lines, District Bhiwani.
2. Upon notice of motion issued, vide order dated 10.05.2024, the State has filed a reply dated 22/27.07.2024, by way of an affidavit of

Sh.Anoop Kumar, DSP, Bhiwani-II, in the Registry of this Court, which is taken on record.

3. As per the reply (*supra*), a number of raids were conducted at different places, including the places pointed out by the petitioner, despite that whereabouts of respondent no.4 has not been ascertained. Reply further reveals that earnest efforts are being made to arrest respondent no.4.

4. From the reply (*supra*), it reflects that the investigation is being carried out in the right direction, therefore, this Court is of the considered view that no further direction is required to be passed, at this stage.

5. Consequently, the instant petition is **disposed of**.

6. It is expected from the authority concerned, to make all further efforts to arrest the proclaimed person-respondent no.4.
