SUVIR SEHGAL J. (ORAL)

1. By way of present writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has *inter alia* sought a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No.1 to 4 to refund the stamp duty and registration fee levied by the respondent-authorities as the same were exempted by virtue of notifications, Annexures P-5 and P-6.

2. During the pendency of the writ petition, a representation moved on behalf of the petitioners, has been rejected by a speaking order dated 22.04.2021, Annexure R-3, passed by SDM, Nawanshahar. This order has been brought on the record by way of an additional affidavit filed on behalf of the official respondents.

3. In view of the subsequent development, the prayer made in the writ petition has become infructuous. However, liberty is granted to the petitioners to take recourse to the remedy available to them in accordance with law in so far as the challenge to the newly passed order is concerned.

4. Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
