The prayer in the petition under Section 482 Cr.PC is for the quashing of the warrant of arrest issued by the Trial Court vide impugned order dated 29.04.2024 (Annexure P-4) in FIR No.162 dated 05.05.2022 under Sections 370, 406, 420 IPC and Section 24 of the Immigration Act, 1983.

On 10.05.2024 the following order was passed:-

“ The Prayer in this petition under Section 482 Cr.PC is for the quashing of the Warrant of Arrest issued by the Trial court vide order dated 29.04.2024 (Annexure P-4) passed in case FIR No.162 dated 05.05.2022 under Sections 370, 406, 420 IPC and Section 24 of Immigration Act, 1983 along with the entire subsequent proceedings.

The Counsel for the petitioner contends that on 29.04.2024 the petitioner had moved an application for



exemption. The said application was rejected leading to the passing of the impugned order. He states that petitioner is ready and willing to join the proceedings once again.

Notice of motion for 06.08.2024.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the Trial Court within a period of one week from today and subject to a deposit of Rs.25,000/- as costs with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Bar Association Account No.65035682434 State Bank of India High Court Branch, IFSC Code SBIN0050306 he shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of the Trial Court.

The petitioner is further directed to place on record the photocopy of receipt of payment as well as the order passed by the court below granting interim bail to the petitioner.”

Despite the passing of the aforementioned orders, the petitioner has not surrendered in compliance of the said order.

In view of the above, the present petition stands dismissed.
