1. The present is a third petition filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.141 dated 24.09.2020, under Sections 21/29/61/85 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Khem Karan, District Tarn Taran.
2. It has been pointed out by the learned State counsel that the petitioner had earlier filed a bail petition which was withdrawn by him vide Annexure P-8 on 29.04.2024 and just after six days, he has filed the present petition which is not maintainable.
3. This Court is of the considered view that when a successive bail petition is filed immediately after withdrawal of the earlier bail petition, then it amounts to seeking review of earlier order in view of the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *State of Madhya Pradesh Vs. Kajad, 2001 (7) SCC 673*. Therefore, the present petition is not maintainable and the same is hereby dismissed.
