1. The present Civil Revision Petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the order dated 06.03.2024 (Annexure P-5) passed by the Family Court, Amritsar vide which application filed by the petitioner under Section 24 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 has been dismissed.
