This is a contempt petition filed under Article 215 of the Constitution of India read with the provisions of Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 01.08.2019 passed in CWP-20042-2018.

Counsel for the respondents submits that in compliance of the order dated 01.08.2019 passed in CWP-20042-2018, necessary orders have been passed and the pay of the petitioner has been fixed. Not only that, even the arrears, as per the revised pay, have also been paid to the petitioner.

In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.

However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-addressed, she would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
