The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in a case bearing FIR No.407 dated 12.12.2023 under Sections 120-B, 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC and Sections 61(1) (c), 72-A of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914 (Sections 201, 272, 273 IPC and Sections 103, 104 of the Trade Marks Act, 1999 were added later on) registered at Police Station Dharuhera, District Rewari.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 10.05.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 10.05.2024 and is not required for custodial interrogation.



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In view of the above, the interim order dated 10.05.2024 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
