KULDEEP TIWARI, J. (Oral)

This Court on 14.10.2021, directed the parties to get their statements recorded before the learned Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court concerned, in order to ascertain the veracity of the compromise as alleged in the instant petition.

Thereupon, again an opportunity was granted on dated 09.02.2022 to the parties to get their respective statements recorded. However, the parties were unsuccessful getting their statements recorded, moreover, no one caused appearance either for the petitioner or for respondent No.2. On the last date of hearing also, no one caused an appearance on behalf of the parties.

It seems that there is no compromise effected between the parties. Further, the learned State counsel on instruction imparted to him by ASI-Ashwani Kumar, inform this Court that after investigation in the instant FIR, cancellation report has already been filed before the learned Illaqa Magistrate concerned.

In view of the specific statement suffered by the learned State counsel, the instant petition is ordered to be dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
