1. Allowed as prayed for.

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1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 21.03.2023 passed in RSA-1325-2008.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. Gunjan Mehta, Addl. A. G. Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel for the respondents that after passing of the order dated 21.03.2023 by this Court, the petitioner was asked to join the duty. However, he never joined the same. As of today, the petitioner has already attained the age of superannuation. Therefore, the petitioner cannot be permitted to join any duty. So far as the inquiries are



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concerned, since the petitioner himself has not joined the duty or come forward to receive the report, therefore, no order could be passed on the same as such.

5. In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to continue with the present petition any more.
