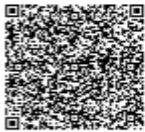

PANKAJ JAIN, J. (Oral)

1. Present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.16 dated 28.02.2024, registered for the offence punishable under Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959 and Section 120-B of IPC, 1860 at Police Station Special Operation Cell, Amritsar, District Tarn Taran.
2. FIR came into being on the secret information received against co-accused Gursahib Singh and some unidentified persons claiming that they are involved in illegal activities and are taking law in their hands by committing serious offences.
3. As per the prosecution, arrest of Gursahib Singh led to recovery of 02 pistols and 01 revolver alongwith 13 live cartridges. Gursahib Singh is further stated to have nominated the present petitioner and it is claimed that the petitioner was found to be in

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round of 32 bore.

4. Counsel for the petitioner relies upon order dated 21.05.2024, whereby Gursahib Singh stands admitted to regular bail in CRM-M-18246-2024.

5. Challan already stands presented. Most of the witnesses are official and thus there cannot be any apprehension that the petitioner shall tamper with the evidence.

6. In view thereof, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

7. Needless to say nothing recorded herein shall be construed to be an expression of an opinion on the merits of the case.
