The aforesaid petition was filed on 09.05.2019 and refiled on 29.10.2019 and further refiled on 09.01.2020 by Mr. Sangeet Pal Singh Baaghi, Advocate. The Registry had raised objection(s) on the case file on 21.09.2019, 27.11.2019 and 09.07.2020.

As per Rule 9, Chapter 1, Part-A, Volume V, Punjab and Haryana High Court Rules and Orders, the petition on which objections have been raised by the Registry is to be taken back by the counsel/party, who filed it, to be re-filed within a total period of 40 days.
