SURESHWAR THAKUR, J. (ORAL)

1. The competent authority concerned is seized with *Annexure P-14*, which is addressed to the Addl. Chief Secretary Mines & Geology, Civil Secretariat Haryana, Chandigarh, and, is also addressed to the Director General, Mines & Geology Department, Haryana, Sector-2, Chandigarh, whereas, the permissible remedy for release of sureties to the present petitioner was to be availed through a motion being made before the District Mining Officer concerned.
2. Consequently, as prayed for by the learned counsel for the petitioner, he is permitted to make a motion or a representation before the District Mining Officer concerned. The said representation be made within a period of one week from today, and, within a period of one month thereafter, it shall be lawfully decided, but only after hearing all affected persons concerned.

3. However, it is open to the respondent-concerned, to before the District Mining Officer concerned, make a submission that the said apposite transfer is against public policy or is against law. The said submission shall also be lawfully considered and decided strictly in accordance with law.
4. Disposed of accordingly alongwith all pending application(s), if any.
