1. The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to them in case FIR No.07 dated 21.01.2024, registered under Sections 323, 325, 452, 506, 148, 149 of IPC, at Police Station Taragarh, Pathankot.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of the order dated 16.05.2024 passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Hem Raj, has submitted that the petitioners have joined the investigation on 30.05.2024 and are no longer required for further investigation.
