1. In the present petition, the grievance being raised by the petitioner is that he is entitled for the benefit of 1st, 2nd and 3rd ACP after completion of 10, 16 and 24 years of service, which benefit is not being granted to him.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is no impediment in the release of the same but the ACP benefits are not being released to the petitioner without any valid justification.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance in the Legal notice dated 18.01.2024 (Annexure P-4) but the same is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a



direction is issued to the respondents to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case, the Legal notice dated 18.01.2024 (Annexure P-4) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order. Learned counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioner, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioner in the speaking order to be passed.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

6. Ordered accordingly.
