The Prayer in this second petition under Section 439 Cr.PC is for the grant of regular bail in case FIR No.172 dated 20.08.2023 under Sections 18, 25, 29, 61 and 85 of NDPS Act and after the arrest of the co-accused Sections 25/54/59 of Arms Act were also added at Police Station Cheharta, District Amritsar.

2. Petitioner-Manjinder Singh and Manvinder Singh @ Mani came to be apprehended with 2Kg 600 Grams of Opium.

3. The Counsel for the petitioner contends that on account of the medical condition of the petitioner who is suffering from Liver disease, he was entitled to the concession of interim bail.

4. The learned State counsel on the other hand contends that the first bail application of the petitioner was argued at length and after this Court was not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, the same was



withdrawn on 01.04.2024. If the petitioner was seeking bail on account of ill health, he being in custody would get adequate treatment from the jail hospital or from some other hospital as per his requirement. Therefore, the petitioner was not entitled to the concession of bail.

5. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.
6. Admittedly, the first bail application of the petitioner came to be withdrawn on 01.04.2024. Surprisingly, the petitioner is suffering from liver disease after few days of withdrawal of his first bail application on 01.04.2024. Be that as it may, at this stage, I do not deem it appropriate to grant the concession of interim bail to the petitioner. Therefore, the present petition stands dismissed.
7. However, the Jail Authorities are directed to provide adequate treatment to the petitioner.
