Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner's services were terminated on the ground that the petitioner is required to submit the Sports Gradation Certificate and in case, he has a valid Sports Gradation Certificate issued under the Policy dated 25.05.2018, he can re-claim the appointment, which was done by the petitioner but the petitioner is not being granted the benefit of the service during which the petitioner remained out of service despite the fact that the petitioner was fully eligible to hold the post.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already filed a representation, which has already been forwarded to the higher authorities vide letter dated 02.01.2023 (Annexure P-5) but no

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final decision is being taken on the said representation, which is causing prejudice to the petitioner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

5. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case, the representation claiming the benefits of the period during which the services of the petitioner were terminated is still pending consideration before the authorities concerned, an appropriate order will be passed within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order and in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioner, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reason will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioner in the speaking order to be passed.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

7. Ordered accordingly.
