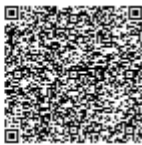

The prayer in the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing the respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6 and to provide security to them.

2. Notice of motion was issued on 09.05.2024.
3. A reply by way of an affidavit of Simranjeet Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Zirakpur, District SAS Nagar (Mohali) dated 03.08.2024 has been filed on behalf of the State, which is taken on record.
4. A perusal of the said reply would reveal that the statements of respondents No.4 to 6, namely, Harinder Kumar, Seems Sharma and Anurag



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Sharma have been recorded on 20.07.2024, as per which they had disclosed that they had filed a complaint against the petitioner at Police Station, Faridabad and they never threatened the petitioners and they would act as per law.

5. Further, as per the enquiry report of SHO, Police Station Zirakpur, there is no threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents or any other person. However, the petitioners have been provided the contact numbers of the local police officials and the Police Control Room, Mohali.

6. In view of the above discussion, no further orders are required to be passed. The present petition stands disposed of.
